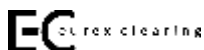

Customer Roadmap

This document specifies in brief the functional and technical changes of the new release. It comprises information on the course of simulation and provides support for an appropriate preparation for production start of the new release.

Description of Reports – Raw Data

With the new CCP release, the following major changes relevant for raw data, file and SWIFT based reports will be introduced:

- settlement account length extension
- removal of MT598 header and footer in all CCP reports distributed via SWIFT network
- new format (XML,TXT) for risk reports distributed via CCP infrastructure

The document specifies the structure of raw data reports available with CCP Release 6.0.

Member File Based & SWIFT Interface

The document contains detailed information about the technical structure of SWIFT-based reporting interfaces between CCP, trading participants, clearing participants and clearing institutes.
